What is an Octave

*“Octave refers to the **eight day period** following a major Feast. In the case of Easter, each day following is a continuation of the celebration of the Feast of Easter (to include the Gloria in the Paul VI Mass and both the Gloria and Creed in the Tridentine Mass) and the Eighth Day (the following Sunday) is also a Feast day, namely, Divine Mercy. We can see a foreshadowing of the importance of the 8th day in the command to circumcise on the 8th day in the Old Covenant.”*
