

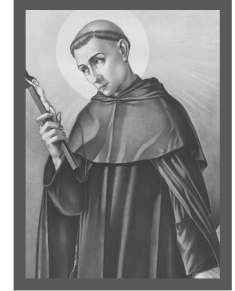

"BLESSING OF THE TEACHERS" ~ Father Nguyen will acknowledge our catechists this Sunday at the 10:30 am Mass by calling them forward to receive a special blessing. Catechesis comes from the Greek and means "to echo or resound" ~ one who teaches in the name of the Church. We want to all reach out and support the "teachers" of our young people - the parents who prepare the soil and plant the seed as primary catechists and those volunteers who make the commitment to be there almost every Sunday for 8 months, sharing their love and faith with the children. Let us pray for and support our teachers! (One of the biggest ways a parent can show support is by bringing your children regularly and on time.)

Religious Education classes for Kindergarten through grade 8 will begin at OLPH on Sunday, September 24th from 9:15 to 10:15 am in the Parish Center. Registration has been before and after the Masses the last 2 weekends and forms are available in the Parish Center as well. If you have questions, contact Betty @ 541-942-3420 ext 103.

The Fall adult education/small faith sharing groups will be starting the week of October 8th. Sign ups for the groups will begin this weekend. We will be continuing "The Journey/El Camino" series that we started during Lent 2017 and continue with Part 3 during Lent 2018. These are available in both English and Spanish.

There are six sessions in Part 2 of **The Journey/El Camino** which explore Jesus and his community:

- **Jesus, Sender of the Spirit** – this session emphasizes the essential role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church and gives participants and opportunity to renew their sense of the Spirit in their lives.
- **Jesus, The Gatherer** – this session helps participants understand that Jesus calls everyone, and calls them into community and mission.
- **Jesus, The Leader** – this session underscores the distinct kind of leadership Jesus gives and bequeaths to his Church: a leadership of humble service.
- **Jesus, the Reconciler** – in this session participants see that rampant conflict can exist even among Christians and come to understand the ongoing need for reconciliation and peace-making in the community of Jesus
- **Jesus, Host of Meals** – Jesus often ministered to people at table. The Eucharist is his greatest table ministry, one that continues in the heart of the Church gives it life today.
- **Jesus, Bringer of the Kingdom** – Jesus' mission was to bring about the Kingdom of God. His community, his people, live for the Kingdom, just as Jesus did.

In these sessions, participants read from a selected Scripture passage and then watch a short video (produced by OBD films). In the video, we see our experiences today as reflected in the experience of those who first encountered Jesus two thousand years ago. We come to see how Christ touches us personally, even today. After watching the video, groups then read over a reflection and discuss questions pertaining to the reading and are encouraged to pray on it in the week ahead - as well as suggested actions of living in our daily life. There is also a space for journaling in the participant booklet (The booklets are for participants to keep.) - to reflect on during the week. The sign up sheets give different times during the week to choose from (choose up to 3 offered times to facilitate group formation); sign ups will then be tabulated to make up 5 groups. Individual groups will meet once a week for about an hour and if groups need to make adjustments to the schedule, they can do so as a group. **Sign up sheets will be available in the vestibules at both Our Lady of Perpetual Help and St Philip Benizi.** Here is an opportunity to grow in your faith and an excellent pre-Advent season activity.
