Ministry commitment sheet explanation

Greeters: You are usually scheduled for this ministry three to four times per year. Arrive at church 20 minutes before Mass begins. Welcome people as they arrive.

Lector: You are scheduled to read (first, second readings & intentions) during Mass about 8 times per year. Arrive at church 20 minutes before Mass begins to make sure everything is set up.

Eucharistic Minister (Mass): You are scheduled to serve at Mass about one time per month. Arrive at church 20 to 30 minutes before Mass begins to set up.

Eucharistic Minister (home communion) Take communion to home bound & hospitalized parishioners.

Altar Servers: You are scheduled to serve at Mass about once or twice a month, depending on the number of volunteers. Arrive at church 20 minutes before Mass begins. Assist Father during Mass. No age limit, but must have received First Communion. Adults are welcome!

Ushers: Serve during Mass, collecting offertory & pass out bulletins after Mass. Occasionally you will be asked to distribute materials during Mass.

Projection Operator: During Mass you operate the computer advancing the slides when needed. You have a sheet to follow to tell you when to advance the next slide.

Prayer Line: Pray for the intentions of those who ask for prayers. You will usually have one person to call in your group. **E-mail prayer line** receives prayer requests through e-mail. All you are asked to do is pray for those people listed----no forwarding or calling others involved.

Church Cleaning: You will be called 1 or 2 times per year to clean the church. It takes about two hours, depending on how many workers you have helping.

Altar Flowers & Decoration: You will be scheduled 1 or 2 times per year to supply flowers, arrange them. Or contribute to the purchase of flowers/plants for church weekend Masses & Holy Days.

Coffee & Donuts Servers: You will be scheduled 2 or 3 times per year. Pick up donuts at Country Donuts on Sunday morning by 9:30 am. Prepare coffee, punch & donuts ready to serve following Mass. Serve & clean up You will be done about 1 pm.

Coffee & Donuts Scheduler: Call parishioner volunteers to schedule them for serving coffee & donuts.

Building Maintenance & Elder Services: You will be contacted as needed for projects.
